(a) briefly describe the main theme(s) in each passage; [4]

(b) briefly explain the importance of these themes in a Muslim's life today. [4]

(b) Why is it significant that the Quraysh were still willing to keep their belongings with the Holy Prophet (S.A.W) after he started to preach Islam? [4]

4. (a) Describe the events that immediately led up to the Holy Prophet's (S.A.W) migration, the Hijra. [10]
(b) Explain the importance of the pledges of 'Aqaba to the Prophet (S.A.W) in the period leading up to the migration. [4]

5. (a) What was the role the scribes played in recording and compiling the revelations? [10]
(b) Explain the importance of methods employed by the compilers of the Quran at the time of the Caliphs. [4]
