This question is about the Early Problems of Pakistan in 1947.

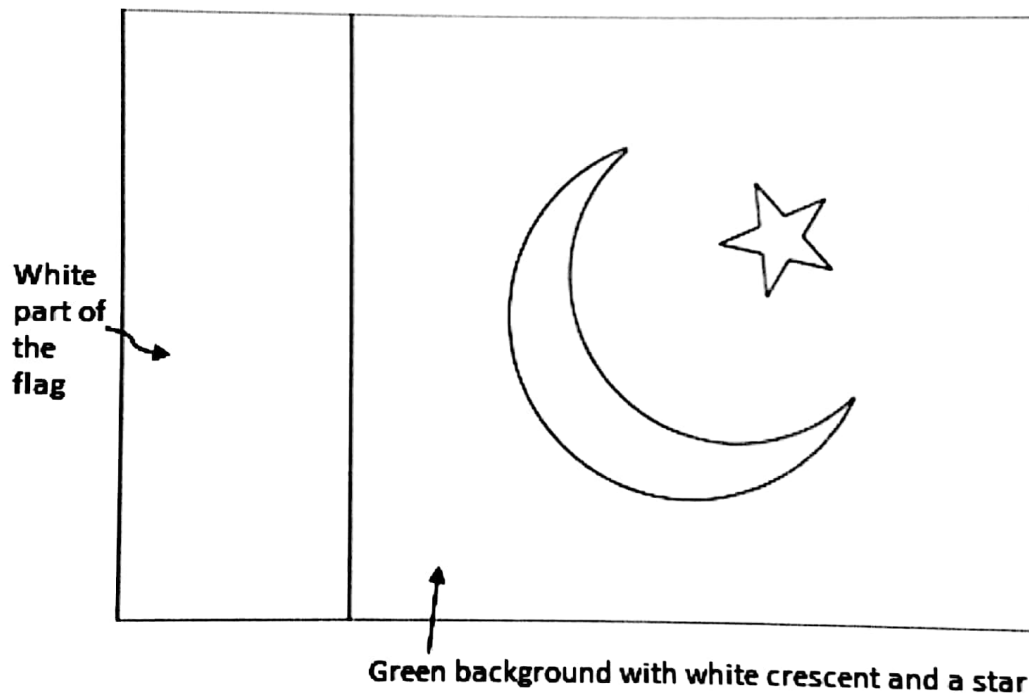
1 Study the sources carefully and then answer the questions which follow
